Superintendent's Highlights

In an effort to promote student and teacher safety, several law enforcement agencies participated in a mock "Active Shooter" emergency drill at the Snake River High School. A more complete emergency training exercise, including a mock evacuation of the staff and students, is being planned.

Responding to the recommendations of a school-community committee, school populations were reconfigured so that all K-2 students are at Moreland Elementary, grade 3 at Riverside Elementary and grade 4 at Rockford Elementary to equalize teacher/pupil ratios, maximize team-teaching and curriculum alignment opportunities and to enhance student unity.
