HOW OUR STUDENTS PERFORMED

The Idaho Standards Achievement Test is an assessment of student knowledge in three areas: reading, math and language usage. Each of the three sub-tests consist of 42 standards-based items, administered via the computer. Aggregate student performance is displayed in terms of percentages of students meeting standards for the grade level at the school, district and state level. Performance improvement goals are set by the state of Idaho in accordance with the federal law known as No Child Left Behind.
