## Sliding Fee Scale payments

To ensure that no patient is denied health care services due to inability to pay, the Community Family Clinic offers a sliding fee discount.

The sliding fee discount for qualifying patients is based on household size and household income. In order to qualify for the discount, patients must provide the following:

- Check stubs for last two months to verify income of all working members of the household.
- All income verification for working household members, including Social Security benefits, alimony benefits, child support, etc.
- Birth certificates or immunization records for all children under 18 years old living at home.
- Proof of current address, such as power, gas, or phone bill.

## Enrollment Counselors

The Community Family Clinic offers enrollment assistance into marketplace insurance, Medicaid and CHIP.

Enrollment Counselors are available year-round for any questions regarding the Affordable Care Act or Medicaid enrollment. Call the Community Family Clinic to make an appointment or to speak to an Enrollment Counselor.
