Policy Title: BOARD MEMBER - VACANCIES	Effective Date: July 18, 2007

A vacancy shall be declared by the district's Board of Trustees when any nominee has been elected but has failed to qualify for office, or within thirty (30) days of when any trustee shall (a) die; (b) resign as trustee; (c) remove themselves from the trustee zone of residence; (d) no longer be a resident or school district elector of the district; (e) refuse to serve as trustee; (f) without excuse acceptable to the Board of Trustees, fail to attend four (4) consecutive regular meetings of the Board; or (g) be recalled and discharged from office as provided in section 33-439, Idaho Code. Such declaration of vacancy may be made at any general or special meeting at which any of the above conditions are determined to exist. In the event of a vacancy, the Board of Trustees, providing there remain a majority, shall appoint to such vacancy a person qualified to serve as trustee, and shall notify the State Superintendent of Public Instruction of the appointment. Such appointment shall be made within ninety (90) days of the declaration of vacancy.

Any person so appointed shall serve until the next annual election of school district trustees, following such appointment, when a trustee shall be elected to complete the unexpired term of the office declared vacant and filled by appointment.
