<b>Policy Title:</b>  <b>Reporting Student Progress</b>	<b>Effective Date:</b>  <b>February 27, 2008</b>

Parents shall be given a complete report of their student's progress several times during the school year. The report may include written and oral communication.

Report cards will be issued six (6) time a year for students on the Trimester system and four (4) times a year for students on the Semester system.

Parent-Teacher Conferences will be held at least twice annually. It is the responsibility of each teacher and administrator to inform parents and students of a student's progress. This is primarily done during the grade reporting period and Parent-Teacher Conferences. These reports are given to ensure that a student has every opportunity to be successful. Timely notification may become an exception under this policy when a grade or credit depends upon a student's performance on a final exam given the last few days of a semester or trimester.

All educators are to follow and support the District Beliefs and Mission Statement as adopted by the Snake River Board of Trustees.
