<b>Policy Title:</b>  <b>CERTIFICATION AND CERTIFICATES</b>	<b>Effective Date:</b>  <b>November 9, 2004</b>

Every person who is employed by the District to serve in an elementary or secondary school in the capacity of teacher or administrator shall be required to have and to hold a certificate issued under authority of the Idaho State Board of Education, valid for the service being rendered. The State Board of Education may authorize endorsement of valid out-of-state certificates for a limited period of time.

Failure to provide an original, valid, current Idaho teaching certificate will result in the withholding of pay.

No certificate shall be required of a student attending any teacher-training institute, who shall serve as a practice teacher in a classroom under the supervision of a certificated teacher, and who is jointly assigned by such institute and approved by the board to perform practice teaching in a non-salaried status. A student, while serving in a practicum, internship, or student teaching position under the supervision of a person certificated pursuant to Idaho Code, shall be accorded the same liability insurance coverage by the district being served as that accorded such certificated person in the same district, and shall comply with all rules and regulations of the district while serving in this capacity.
