<p>In order to attend school in the Snake River School District 52, a student must meet one of the following criteria:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Live with one or both parents.</li> <li>2. Live with a legal guardian.</li> <li>3. Live as a foster child assigned by appropriate authorities.</li> </ol> <p>Snake River School District 52, in keeping with Idaho Code 33-1402 and 33-1404, will allow open enrollment for out-of-district students to the extent that they can be accommodated at each facility and grade level annually. Students may be admitted to the district who live with an adult who has power of attorney for matters of health and education and who meet the district's open enrollment criteria.</p> <p>Any student applying for admittance to Snake River School District under the open enrollment law, will be required to submit the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1.
