The Board assumes no responsibility for control over such items as travel, living accommodations, funding, insurance, etc., which remain the responsibility of the sponsoring program, host family, and student.</p> <p>Exchange students will be accepted to the extent that they can be accommodated. However, no more than six (6) Exchange Students will be accepted by the District in any given school year.
